- The selected agency shall have complete responsibility to provide required manpower, operated & manage ICU/ Oxygen and non oxygen beds units completely with proper co-ordination and best possible professional skills, 24 X 7 at the jumbo facility centres.
- The tentative manpower required per day for 10 beds unit of ICU be as follows.

- Working in rotation system in shift duties to be allowed.
- The insurance, food, accommodation, transportation or any other facility will be provided by the service provider.
- With regards to food, 1 breakfast/ snacks and either lunch or dinner on duty will be provided by MCGM.
- There should be a Bio-medical engineer available with service provider managing ICU.
- For better management of the facility the ICU beds to be arranged into units consisting of up to 10 beds
- MCGM will provide entire infrastructure of ICU units medicines and consumables only. Consequently, it will be the sole responsibility of the service provider to take utmost and diligent care of all the patients admitted in the ICU to the optimum level.
- The minimum qualification of manpower to be appointed by service provider in ICU/ DCHC unit shall be as follows:


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- MCGM will provide the ICU set up with ventilator beds, machinery, medicines / pharmacy, PPE kits, logistics, laboratory, security, foods to the patient, required for operation & management of ICU. The bidder has to deploy necessary manpower (like consultants, RMO doctors, nurses, wardboys, PCAs, technicians etc. as per the actual requirement) so as to operate and manage the ICU seamlessly and professionally for taking optimum care of the patients
- Bidder can quote for one facility or more facilities. But service provider should not be given more than 2 facilities to manage.
- All Bidders to be evaluated by a **Evaluation Committee** under the chairmanship of Additional Municipal Commissioner (W.S.) <sup>Jt. M.C. (Improvement)</sup> with Deputy Municipal Commissioner (Public Health), Director (M.E. & M.H.), Nodal Co-ordinator of all Jumbos, C.A. (Finance), and Asstt. Comm. (Estates) as members, on the prescribed date and time as informed with one day notice. The bid should be evaluated based on the following key areas:

1. Quality of Service

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2. Qualification of the manpower to be provided
  3. Financial aspects
  4. Experience of the firm and manpower to be provided
  5. Any other factors as decided by the committee.

The offer of bidders qualified by Technical evaluation Committee should only be considered on merit basis. MCGM should reserve the right to change or cancel this E.O.I. without assigning any reasons, to accept or reject any or all expressions of interest without incurring any obligation to inform the affected Applicant/s of the grounds. Any costs associated with the submission of the E.O.I. will have to be borne by the Applicant and any such associated costs will not be reimbursed by MCGM.

- The bidder/service provider should be either a corporate hospital/Organization /Association of Doctors/ Limited Company/Private Limited Company / Partnership or Proprietary Firm / NGO / Trust) providing Intensive care services.
- Bidder having adequate knowledge and expertise in providing Intensivist services for Covid ICU/MICU/TICU/SICU/ICCU/ wards/ DCHC activities should be given preference.
- The service provider shall possess adequate nurses and ward boys and qualified doctors in the respective field.
- The decision of the Municipal Commissioner should be final and binding. The Municipal Commissioner should reserves the right to split the quantity amongst the eligible bidders and to relax/restrict any of the conditions of the tender without assigning any reasons. The Municipal Commissioner should reserve right to reject any or all offers without assigning any reasons.
